Title Sixth Ward Meet and Greet Night

August 4, 2016

What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
Parents will meet with teachers for the 16-17 school session and become aware of policies and procedures for the school year, including the Title I plan. Curriculum and homework policies will be discussed.

Title SWE – Pre K Success

August 9, 2016

What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
Parents will meet with their child's teacher and the Instructional Coach to be given guidelines and milestones achieved in the Pre K program. Tips and suggestions for at home practice and expanding developmental language will be given to support the successful integration of school life for these young students.

Title SWE - Keys to Success in Kindergarten

Oct. 4, 2016

What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
Kindergarten parents will meet with their child's teacher and the Instructional Coach to be presented with strategies, policies, procedures, and tools to expand developmental language. This will assist their child in attaining Kindergarten standards and prepare students for the rigor of the CCSS curriculum.

Title SWE – Keys to Success in First Grade

Sept. 13, 2016

What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
First grade teachers will present parents with an outline of methods in assisting their children with getting ready to read, and things they could do with their child at home to facilitate this process.

Title SWE – Keys to Success in Second Grade

Sept. 15, 2016

What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
Second grade teachers will meet with parents to give assistance in understanding the transition into the new CCSS math and reading skills and how they align with their student's daily instruction. Strategies for the parents to work with their children on their home assignments will be presented.

Title SWE – Keys to Success in Third Grade

Sept. 20, 2016

What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
Third grade parents will be taught new methods used by their children in the new CCSS math curriculum and ways they can assist their children at home in understanding these strategies.

Title SWE – Fourth Grade Bullying Prevention

Sept. 22, 2016

What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance?
Parents will meet with the fourth grade teachers and will be given characteristics of bullying behavior, how to communicate with their child about bullying, and what steps to take if they are a victim of bullying.
